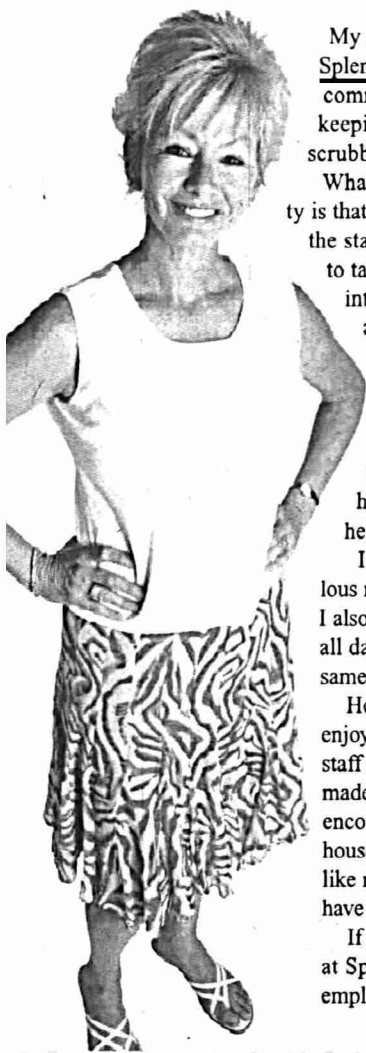


# I Love My Job!
